

Winter War

Winter War is a Borealis event that opens the war season. The event includes many challenges which points are won for Borealis or for the World. This year points were given for Bardic, Arts and Science, Archery, Rapier, Heavy and a Volunteer's point.

This year, The World took Bardic and Rapier. The Heavy point was declared a tie, and the home Barony took the Arts and Science, Archery and the Volunteer point. Huzzah!

Congrats to Borealis's new laurel and Pelican

The Order of the Laurel was one of the first peerage orders created by the Society. Intially created as a way to recognize all excellence off the field. the first Laurel was granted during the West Kingdom's Twelth Night, AS II (Jan 6, 1968). At first, both Arts and Science as well as Service were rewarded with a Laurel, until the creation of a sister Order of the Pelican to recognize service a few years later.


As with the other Peerage orders, being a member of the Laurel has some privlages. They are now entitled to be referred to as "Mistress" or "Master", and they are allowed to wear the symbol of their Order, which is a Laurel branch.

The Order of the Pelican is a Society wide order for those who are recognized for their ongoing and persistent service to the Society. It was proposed and created in the early days of the Society, when several members, primarily in the Kingdom of the West, realized there was a need to recognize those who helped form and make the Society though their service. Until that point, those who served with distinction were inducted into the Order of the Laurel, but it was decided that creating two sister Peerage Orders allowed for people to receive the recognition that they deserved, in their chosen fields.

There is nothing that prevents anyone from being a member of both orders, as some of the qualities that serve well in one Order can also be highly sought after in the other, as some of our own resident multi-peers display very elegantly. Your Highness and Your Excellency, I'm looking your general directions.

As it is a peerage Order, it does allow members certain privileges. A Pelican are now titled as "Master or Mistress" as suits them, are allowed to wear the symbol of their Order, which is officially termed "a Pelican in it's Peity". They are also allowed to wear as outrageous red hat as they wish. Naturally some take to that practice more than others.
