Tremember When... By Yamadi Blackeye

Stories from times past

I remember my first real war event. It was about 7 years ago when we were able to have Winter War at Griesbach, the old army base just off of 97th Street and 137th Ave.

For me, there were a couple of stand out things that happened during this years war. One was for Rapier, and the other one happened during the Heavies part.

I wasn't authorized to play in the rapier part of the war then, so I got to have a birds eye view from the bleachers that were well above the floor of the enormous gym that this building housed.

After the Rapier Mercenaries had accepted the SCA's form of payment/bribe (4 litre ice cream pails of home made chocolate chip cookies) the teams gathered onto their respective sides of the fighting area.

There was everyone else, and quite a few white scarfs, facing off, and out numbering the Borealians and anyone else that they could get to help flesh out their numbers.




