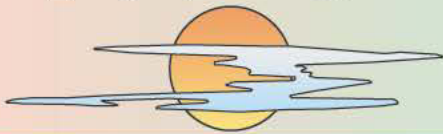

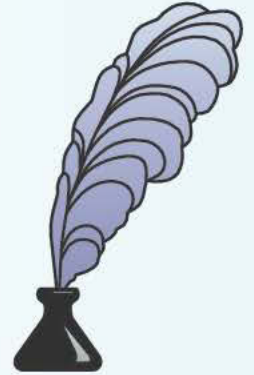

Archery News

CRAC has announced their new location will be opening in May of 2012. There are a few specifics still needing to work out, but this is what is known so far;

Because the current locations building was deteriorating beyond usable condition, and the lease was expiring anyhow, a new location was needed. One was found at 5618 - 76 ave, Edmonton. The new facility has a 20 yard (18 meter) indoor range, wide enough for 13 - 14 archers on a shooting line. There is also a sitting area and a club room

Hopefully there will be some more specific details to follow on how the new location will affect us (i.e. storage room). Instead of key locks at the new location, there will be an electronic locking system.

Between April 12th and May 15th, Shooting may be temporarily suspended. Other arrangements

might be able to be made to shoot at a different range for that time period.

Fees for the new range should be the same as the current pricing grid (24/7 access for CRAC members, \$5 drop-in on a nightly basis for non-members). Anyone wishing for a CRAC membership, let Somerled know and he will retrieve a form for you (CRAC office is open 10am - 12pm on Saturdays, plus during their classes to pay for membership).

The Archers are after anyone with information on a 40 yard facility that will allow combat/crossbows.
