Mushroom Tart

One of my favourite recipes. I like to cook the mushrooms a day ahead and let them rest in the fridge overnight. The filling also freezes great so you can make it ahead and slightly defrost before adding to you pie crust.

1-2 lbs. Mushrooms1-2 cups Swiss cheese1-2 tsp. Powder FinePie Crust

Sauté mushrooms in small amount of oil to cook the mushrooms and release their water. Drain and cool. Mix with the spice powder and cheese place into the pie crust and bake at 375 degrees for 30 minutes until done.

Source [Le Ménagier de Paris, J. Hinson (trans.)] 14th Century: Mushrooms of one night be the best and they be little and red within and closed at the top; and they must be peeled and then washed in hot water and parboiled and if you wish to put them in a pasty add oil , cheese and spice powder.

Item, put them between two dishes on the coals and then add a little salt, cheese and spice powder. They be found at the end of May and June.
