

COOKING CORNER - with

Thomas Jusser, writing in 1580, mentions "The Seede Cake" as traditional for the feast that marked the end of the spring wheat sowing. My favorite version of the seed oake, came from an English friend. She said that this recipe had been in her family for a long time, and indeed, it is so simple to make that it seems quite likely. Her version is called "Anise Wedding Bread", and was traditional at weddings in the small village where she grew up. It is very light, with a refreshing taste of anise.

Anise Wedding Bread

- 4 eggs, separated
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 tbsp. vanilla extract (or less)
- 1 cup sifted flour
- 1/2 tap salt
- 1 to 2 tbsp. anise seed

Beat egg whites til stiff. Beat yolks slightly, gradually add sugar to yolks and beat til lemon-colored. Add vanilla. Sift flour with salt. Mix in anise seed. Add to yolk mixture and beat thoroughly. Fold in egg whites. Pour batter into a lightly greased 9x13" pan; bake at 375 for about 25 minutes. Top should be lightly brown and springy to touch.
