





CREAMED CABBAGE SOUP

This soup brought rave reviews and many recipe requests at the last Groaning Board event (Feb 11).

```
2 cans (14 oz) chicken broth
2 celery ribs
1 medium head cabbage, shredded (3 lbs)
1 medium onion, chopped
1 carrot, diced
1/4 c butter
3 tbsp flour
1 tsp salt
1/4 tsp pepper
1 c light cream (half & half)
2 c milk (homo)
2 c cubed fully cooked ham
1/2 tsp dried thyme
chopped parsley (handful)
```

In large kettle, mix broth, celery, cabbage, onion, & carrot. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat, cover, simmer for 20 minutes or until the vegetables are tender (not mushy). Meanwhile, melt butter, add flour, salt & pepper. Stir to make a paste (I use a whisk). Slowly add mixed cream and milk, stirring (whisking) constantly. Cook and stir 'til thickened. Continue cooking one minute longer. Gradually stir into vegetable mixture. Add ham, thyme and heat through. Garnish with parsley. Yield 8-10 servings.

f. Baron and Baroness

Baroness Adelaine read a letter of thanks received from the Baron and Baroness of Madrone, thanking Borealis for the hospitality extended to them during Jul Feast. Special thanks was extended to Sgt. John McLeod; Sgt. Kennet; and Yeoman Mordecai for their personal help.

Their Excellencys' schedule of events will be posted in the next issue of the Aurora.

3. Old Business

- a. Baroness Adelaine announced that she had been informed by the Kingdom Exchequer that all finances related to the SCA must be directed through the Baronial Exchequer. This includes the Sergeant's and guild funds. Canton-level funds would be directed through the appropriate Canton Exchequer. Each account would require three signing authorities. The Baronial Exchequer must be made aware of all expenditures and deposits.
- b. Baroness Adelaine reported that the positions of Baronial Exchequer and Arts & Sciences Officer have become vacant. Anyone interested in applying for either of these positions should contact both the Baronial Seneschal and the Baron and Baroness.
- c. Plans for the Provincial Museum demo are progressing well. A meeting with the organizing committee, the Baron and Baroness, and the Museum will be held on February 10 to formalize the SCA's involvement in the demo.
- d. Valgard af hus Vendrer reported that he would be purchasing material for the Baronial pavilion and hoped to begin work on sewing it within the next few weeks. An advance was approved for the purchase of the material.
- e. Mordecai Salzer announced that an Avacal mailing list was now available for all those with access to an e-mail address. Baron Alfeim stated that he was hoping to have access to e-mail soon.

4. New Business

- a. The first Baronial Fencing Championship will be held today. Alphonse de Lorraine offered to make and donate a half-cape to be passed from champion to champion. The cape will display the Baronial badge surmounted over crossed rapiers. The Baron and Baroness thanked Alphonse for his generous offer.
- b. Baroness Adelaine announced that a new policy will be instated requiring the Chronicler's to ensure no Baronial events are scheduled which would conflict with Tier I events. If such an event is scheduled, the Chronicler's will notify the event autocrat requesting a new date be set. All Tier I events are set at least one year in advance. Autocrats are requested to publish event dates in both the Avantgarde and the Aurora as quickly as possible.
