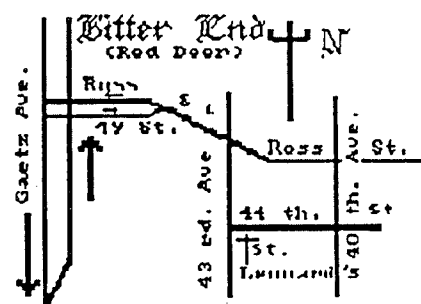
DIRECTIONS:
