

Now behold the fourth rede: If evil witch bideth Woe-begetting by the way, It is good to go further Rather than guesting there, Though thick night be on thee.


Far-seeing eyes

The Grouning Board Library of Recipes

We receive many requests for recipes used for various feasts over the year. To encourage the populace to try new and exciting foods we will (from time to time) publish the ones we have researched.

Included with each recipe will be a short history of the dish. History is a major part of any "really good" food. It enhances the taste by creating mystery and timelessness; and adds the flavor of atmosphere that makes the food all the more enjoyable.

Douce Ame (Sweet Measure)

The following is for Douce Ame (Sweet Measure) and comes from the "Forme of Cury (Manner of Cooking)" commissioned by Richard II for his coronation feast.

Take gode cowe mylke and do it in a pot. Take parsel, sawge, ysope, savray and oother gode herbes. Hewe hem, and do hem in the mylke and seeth hem, clarified. Salt it and colour it with safron and serve it forth.

1 chicken or same weight in chicken breasts ½ c. Flour (with salt and pepper)
3 tbsp oil
3c. milk
1/3 c. honey
½ tsp sage
½ tsp savory
saffron to taste (1 to 2 tsp)
½ c. pine nuts
parsley for garmish

Dredge fowl in flour mixture. Brown chicken in oil until golden. Place browned fowl in saucepan. Combine mild, honey and herbs in a bowl, and use to deglaze pan. Pour mixture over fowl. Cover and simmer for about ½ to ¾ of an hour or until sauce has thickened and chicken is cooked. Check seasoning. Stir in pine nuts just before serving. Serve on a bed of rice, garnish with parsley. Enjoy.
